
Prairie Lite Guidelines




Case 1. Glass Width and Height ≥ 20"

 Prairie patterns for these units will have approximately a 4" daylight between the bars and the edge of glass.




Case 2. 14" ≤ Glass Width or Height < 20"

 Prairie patterns for these units will have approximately a 3" daylight in the short dimension while still maintaining a 4" daylight in the long dimension.



Case 3. Glass Width or Height < 14"

Prairie patterns for these units will have <u>No Bars</u> parallel to the long dimension while still
maintaining a 3" or 4" daylight in the other direction.



<u>IMPORTANT</u>: When ordering windows or doors with prairie lite patterns, it is the customer's responsibility to make sure the grilles align in any mulled or combination unit. **Orders for Prairie** units with bar spacing other than described above will require a customer approval drawing
